

IRS Form 8879 (Page 1)

What is it?

- Form 8879 is a form **required** by the IRS for every return type
- By signing this form you agree to have your return submitted to the IRS

Where do I sign?

- There is only one signature per Taxpayer/Spouse at the bottom of the page
- **ONLY** the taxpayer/spouse needs to sign this form:

Bank Consent Pages (Pages 2 & 3)


What is it?

- These pages are **required** by the bank for a RAC or DDRAC
- For an EFILE Only or Paper return this form will **NOT** appear, nor is it required
- By signing this form you agree to share your tax information with EPS Financial, the bank which processes the RAC refund check (or deposit)

Where do I sign?

- There are two signatures per Taxpayer/Spouse

- **ONLY** the Taxpayer/Spouse needs to sign these forms
- The first signatures are on Page 2 *Consent to Disclosure of Tax Return Information*
- The second signatures are on Page 3 *Consent to Use of Tax Return Information*

e-Collect Taxpayer Agreement (Pages 4 through 10)

What is it?

- These pages are **required** by the bank for a RAC or DDRAC
- For an EFILE Only or Paper return this form will **NOT** appear, nor is it required
- These pages describe the RAC/DDRAC product and explain that fees will be taken from the refund deposited by the IRS and disbursed in the method chosen (a check for a RAC or a deposit for a DDRAC)
- By signing this form you agree to have **ALL** fees taken out of your refund when, and only when, it is deposited to the bank by the IRS

Where do I sign?

- There is one signature per Taxpayer/Spouse
- **ONLY** the Taxpayer/Spouse needs to sign this form

- The signature is on Page 10 of the signature pages
